MN Police Association: Another expert departs from prosecution of Londregan. Why in the world does this continue?

(St. Paul, Minn.) -- A second use of force expert, Jody Stiger, has removed himself from the prosecution team of Trooper Ryan Londregan. Minnesota Police and Peace Officers Association General Counsel and former prosecutor Imran Ali said,

“The whole nation is watching the chaos explode at the Hennepin County Attorney’s Office. The head of the criminal division who signed Mr. Londregan’s complaint has resigned, the lead prosecutor asked to be removed, and with no prosecutors ethically willing to handle the case, the county attorney has hired million dollars lawyers from DC.

If that wasn’t bad enough, we learned today that another use of force expert has departed this unjust prosecution. Why in the world does this continue?

Enough is enough. Governor Walz must immediately act to stop this unfathomable miscarriage of justice.”
